## How to Host a Successful Toy Drive!



### PROMOTE

### COLLECT

You're welcome to use your own collection bins, or we can provide them for you. Be sure to place your collection site in a location that is easy to find and access. Make sure to clearly display a sign about your toy drive next to or on your collection bins. There's one in this tool kit to help!
